INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUBMITTING THE APPLICATION

1. Name of the candidate shall be as in the Qualifying Certificate and the Ph.D. Registration Order.
2. The following enclosures should form part of the application.
 - (i). Hall Ticket format with the columns filled in, along with photograph, as per directions.
 - (ii) Self-attested copy of the Qualifying Certificate.
 - (iii) Copy of the Ph.D. Registration Order duly attested by the Research Guide.
 - (iv) Self-Attested copy of the original M. Phil. Degree (in applicable cases).
 - (v) Chalan –slip in original for the prescribed examination fee.
(Fee can be paid online through **SBI Collect via University web portal.**)
 - (vi) Self-addressed, duly stamped envelope (23x11 cms.) for sending the hall ticket by registered Post.
3. The cover containing the application should have the superscription APPLICATION FOR THE Ph.D. COURSE WORK EXAMINATION
4. Applications should be addressed to Head of Research Centre or Course work Co Ordinator concerned.
5. Applications received after the last date will not be accepted, under any circumstances.
6. Defective applications or applications not accompanied by the requisite documents / the prescribed fee, will be summarily rejected.

General instructions:

1. Candidates are eligible to apply for the course work examinations whose effective date of registration is on or after 01-07-2009.
2. Candidate registered for Course work has to qualify the Course work examination within one year of date of registration of Course work. Registration of candidates who fail to qualify the Course work Examination even after the supplementary chance will stand cancelled automatically.
3. There will be no revaluation of Course work examination.
4. The Research Scholars will be allowed to continue their research programme only on production of their coursework pass certificates.
5. Duration of each paper: 3 hours.
6. Maximum marks: 100
7. Minimum for a pass: **55 marks in each paper.**
8. The condition stipulated in “Kannur University Minimum Standard and Procedure for Ph.D. Degree Regulations – 2018” and the orders and directions issued from time to time shall stand.

1. All Columns in the application form should be carefully filled in by the candidate in his/her own handwriting.
2. All enclosures should be placed between the application form and the hall ticket, neatly secured with tag/twine.

INSTRUCTION TO CANDIDATES:

1. Candidates should enter the examination hall at least 20 minutes before the commencement of the examination. Those reporting after half an hour from the commencement of Examination will not be admitted to the examination hall. Persons suffering from infectious diseases will not be admitted for the examination. **Candidates should bring their hall ticket for the examination and make it available for verification by the invigilator on duty or by any other authorized person.**
2. Candidates are prohibited from writing upon their hall tickets / question papers. They are also prohibited from writing their names on any part of the answer books. Further they shall not write their Register number on any part of the answer book, except in the space provided for in the facing sheet.
3. Candidates are not allowed to carry mobile phones in the examination hall.
4. Calculators can be used in certain examinations with the permission of the Chief Superintendents of the examination centre.
5. Candidates cannot leave the Examination hall prior to 30 minutes from the closing time of Examination.
6. Candidates are prohibited from bringing into the examination hall any book or portion of a book manuscript or paper of any description or from communicating with any person outside the examination hall. Any candidate found violating any of the rules relating to the conduct of examinations will be sent out of the hall forthwith and he/she will not be permitted to attend the remaining papers.
7. Candidates shall handover the answer book to the invigilator on duty before leaving the examination hall.
