Plagiarism defined





"Plagiarism"

Latin word "Plagiarius"

= to kidnap or kidnapper

It is something connected to theft

Now it is commonly used to describe literary theft

So in our context of Research or academic writing it denotes copying other's works without acknowledging them.

Today, "plagiarism" is the term used to describe the act of presenting someone else's work or ideas as your own, without proper attribution.

Direct plagiarism

A person copies someone else's work without giving proper credit. It involves taking entire sentences, paragraphs or pages from a source without using quotation marks or citing the original author.

Self plagiarism

Also known as auto plagiarism, is when someone submits their own previously published work as a new one without proper submission. Reusing one's own work without acknowledgement.

Mosaic plagiarism

Patch writing- Involves taking bits and pieces from various sources and integrating them into one's own work without proper citation.

Accidental plagiarism

When a person unintentionally fails to give proper credit to the original source. Just because of poor understanding of citation rules, poor note taking or careless mistakes



POLICY ON PLAGIARISM CHECKING

Kannur University has formulated a policy on prevention of plagiarism in accordance with the guidelines given by UGC in this regard.

The ideas and suggestions given in the policy are adapted from and integrated with University Grants Commission (Promotion of Academic Integrity and Prevention of Plagiarism in Higher Education Institutions) Regulations – 2017.

Objectives

1. To create academic awareness about responsible conduct of research, study, project work, assignment, thesis, dissertation, promotion of academic integrity and prevention of misconduct including plagiarism in academic writing among students, researchers, faculty and other members of academic staff of Kannur University.

2. To establish institutional mechanism through education and training to facilitate responsible conduct of research, study, project work, assignment, thesis, dissertation, promotion of academic integrity and deterrence from plagiarism.

3. To develop systems to detect plagiarism and to set up mechanisms to prevent plagiarism and punish a student, faculty, or staff of Kannur University committing the act of plagiarism.

Zero Tolerance Policy in core area

The core work carried out by the student, faculty, staff and researcher shall be based on original ideas and shall be covered by Zero Tolerance Policy on Plagiarism. In case Plagiarism is established in the core work claimed then Plagiarism Disciplinary Authority (PDA) of Kannur University shall impose maximum penalty.

The core work shall include abstract, summary, hypothesis, observations, results, conclusions and recommendations.

Levels of Plagiarism in non-core areas

For all other (non-core) cases, plagiarism would be quantified into following levels in ascending order of severity for the purpose of its definition:

- 1. Similarities up to 10% .- excluded
- 2. 2. Level 1: Similarities above 10% to 40%
- 3. 3. Level 2: Similarities above 40% to 60%
- 4. 4. Level 3: Similarities above 60%

Detection/Reporting/Handling of Plagiarism

If any member of the academic community suspects with appropriate proof that a case of plagiarism has happened in any document, he or she shall report it to the competent/designated authority of the university.

Upon receipt of such a complaint or allegation the university authority shall refer the case to the **Academic Misconduct Panel (AMP)** of Kannur University who in turn shall submit a report to the **Plagiarism Disciplinary Authority (PDA)**.

Every research scholar shall submit an undertaking to the University, duly certified by the supervisor, at the time of submission of thesis indicating that the document has been prepared by him/her and that the document is his,/her original work and free of any plagiarism.

Every research scholar shall submit an undertaking to the University at the time of submission of thesis granting the permission to the University and INFLIBNET, the non exclusive license to host the thesis, on University repository/Shodhganga platform under the CC BY-NC license and to preserve as part of the backup.

Every research scholar shall ensure that the thesis contains one page plagiarism checking certificate issued by the Central Library.

Plagiarism checking service is available from 10.30a.m. to 4.30 p.m.at the Central Library.

For plagiarism checking, submit the application to the Central Library in the prescribed format available on the website duly signed by the research scholar and recommended by the supervisor and Head of the Research centre.

Submit the fee receipt for plagiarism checking along with the application.

Regarding self plagiarism, the UGC public notice no. F 1-I/2020 (SECY) dtd. 2010412020 will be applicable.

The supervisor is the authority to exclude the similarities if identified by the plagiarism checking software in the following contexts:

All quoted work reproduced with all necessary permission and/or attribution

All references, bibliography, table of content, preface and acknowledgements

All generic terms, laws, standard symbols and standard equations and

Standard terminology, standard procedure/ protocol/common knowledge, commonly used expressions, properly cited information, researcher's own publication if cited properly in the thesis.

The permissible limit of plagiarism is I 0%.

Download the format for plagiarism checking certificate from the website of Central Library, fill the necessary columns and submit the printout along with the application for checking plagiarism.

The soft copy of the Ph.D thesis should be mailed to plagiarism@kannuruniv.ac.in as a single file in PDF or word format with title page and chapters from introduction to conclusion only, excluding auxiliary pages like declaration, certificate, acknowledgement, table of contents, appendices, references at the end of chapters, bibliography etc.

In the case of theses in regional languages, the soft copy should be submitted in Unicode format only.

The soft copy of thesis should be submitted to the library for checking plagiarism, at least 7 working days before the due date of submission of thesis to the University.

. Summary of the report of the plagiarism check will be send to the e-mail of research scholar.

Citations vs. References

These two terms are often confused. So what's the difference?

"An in-text citation gives the author of the source (often a signal phrase), the date of publication, and at times a page number in parentheses. At the end of the paper, a list of references provides publication information about the source" (Hacker, 2010, p. 469).

In-text citation example (used only in the body of the paper):

As researchers Yanovski and Yanovski (2002) have explained, obesity was once considered "either a moral failing or evidence of underlying psychopathology" (p. 592).

Reference example (used only in a reference list at the end of a paper):

Yanovski, S.Z., & Yanovski, J.A. (2002). Durg therapy: Obesity. *The New England Journal of Medicine*, 346, 591-602.

Self-Citation?

Self-citation is a common practice in academic writing that involves citing one's own previously published work in a new publication. It can include citing articles, books, book chapters, conference papers, or any other type of publication that the writer has authored.

Self-citation can be done in text or in the reference list.

The primary goal of self-citation is to establish a link between a writer's current research and their previous work.

It can be used to build on previous findings, reinforce arguments, or demonstrate continuity in a writer's research.























Plagiarism Checking









